

Footpath Work.

From March to July 2007.

1. FP 28a 778 1840 replace stile with metal kissing gate.
2. 28a 778 1840 replace stile with metal gate
3. 28a 778 1870 install metal gate to the left of the five bar gate.
4. 28a 771 1835 install metal gate , stile already removed.
5. 28a /b & 21b/c 7725 1840 install wooden gate and 4 way finger post.
6. 21a/b & 20 7720 1852 install wooden gate and 3 way finger post.
7. 20 7760 1860 install wooden gate and clear brambles.

Yellow arrows fitted where necessary for bridleways and footpaths.

The aim of this work was to create an easy access footpath of about a mile but the objections of one landowner after initially giving permission did not allow us to complete the project, 4 more gate are required.

Two metal gates recently installed have been removed and replaced with wooden gate following objections for another landowner.

We now have 5 metal gates in stock, we will try now to find sites for them.

Stile removed belonging to Hastings Ramblers see 7 above, Reg arranged for them to collect .

Other stiles left on site.
