

**Risk Assessment for the May Fayre to be held on the Village Green on the 2<sup>nd</sup> of May from 2.0pm to 5.0pm . Assessment carried out by Bob Harris and Ralph Dellow on the 19<sup>th</sup> of February.**

**All the items listed below are low risk with exception of the May Pole dance , the barbecue , teas and skittles.**

**The May pole will be placed on The Green opposite the Brickwall Hotel and the area will be 'fenced' around with split posts , flags at the top of the post and rope halfway down. Each of the two wardens on duty will be stand at the road sides and hope fully the PCSO too.**

**The barbecue will be placed near the pumphouse with the servers back to the building The area roped to the side and the volunteer on duty asked not to leave the site at anytime.**

**We would like to offer teas and coffees but at the moment we have no appropriate site with power etc. It is likely at this stage that there will be no hot drinks.**

**For the first time skittles will be offered. The risk here is not to the players or onlookers but to the balls running into the road. The skittle end will be protected to prevent stray balls running into the road.**

**The other tables and sideshows on offer all at low risk, they will be :-**
