

NOVEMBER 2008

I have been patrolling Sedlescombe, Cripps Corner, Staplecross, Ewhurst Green and Bodiam regularly by car and on foot. Speed checks, school patrols and off-license checks are conducted regularly. I have also been assisting Police Officers in other areas when required for traffic accidents, house to house enquiries, scene guarding or general intelligence gathering. I have been patrolling the lanes regularly at night. I have attended Battle, Rye and Sedlescombe bonfire events.

SEDLSCOMBE

An assault took place at the Halloween disco at the Queens Head. The youths involved had been previously banned. This matter is being investigated and the youths involved will be dealt with accordingly.

I attended the bonfire night at the Queens Head. Although a wet night there was a good turnout and no problems.

Two youths were seen messing around with cars in Gregory's Walk. Nothing was stolen and no damage was caused.

Some very young local youths have been knocking on an elderly person's window. Youths were given very strong words of advice.

Local youths were reported damaging a neighbour's car. The incident is currently being investigated.

There was a collision between 2 vehicles on the Street. There were no injuries but the road was closed off for a short period of time.

2 dogs were stolen from a property in Reservoir Lane. The dog warden has been notified.

CRIPPS CORNER

No crimes reported but there were two road accidents. The B2244 was closed off from Hurst Lane to Cripps Corner on the 6th in the morning due to a collision between a Land Rover and a lorry. There were no serious injuries. Secondly, 2 lorries collided with one lorry not stopping. There were no injuries although there was considerable damage to the vehicle.

STAPLECROSS

A person visiting a friend left his car overnight with the keys in the ignition. He returned the following morning to find his car gone! Enquiries taking place. Please be aware of vehicle crime, make sure all valuable items are removed and the vehicle is left secure.

A traffic accident occurred in the very early hours at Rock Hill. There were no serious injuries and in a second accident a driver ended up in a hedge on a sharp bend. There was no injury to driver or damage to vehicle.

A nuisance male was reported. He was subsequently approached and taken home.

2 trees were cut down and taken away from a private residence. A small rounded shaped orange/peach van was reported seen. Can you provide information regarding this van?
