When considering each question, think also of how many people you may have using your broadband connection at any one time and how that is likely to affect your response.

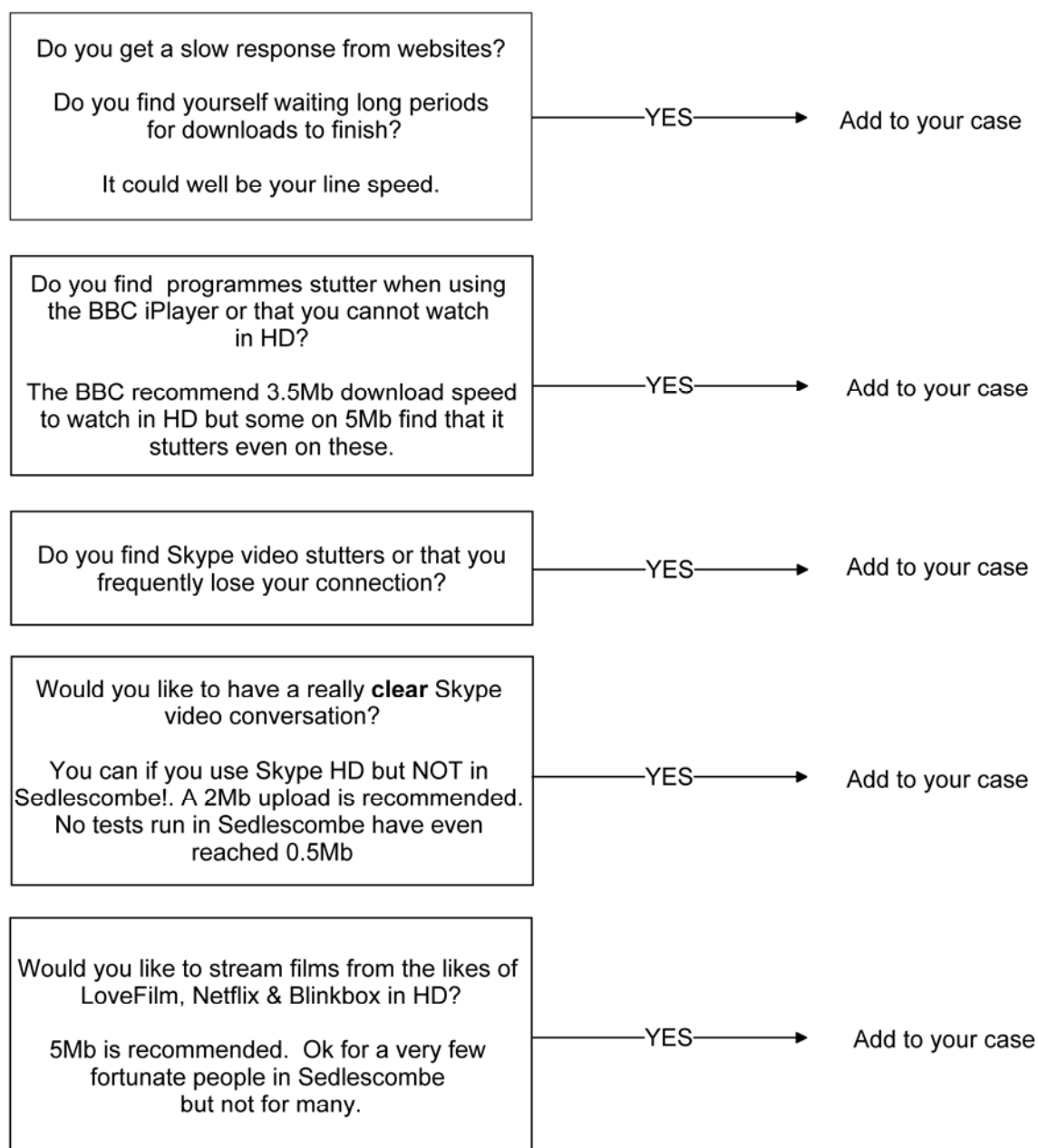
If the answer to a question at present is 'No', say if you think this will change to a 'Yes' within the next two years.

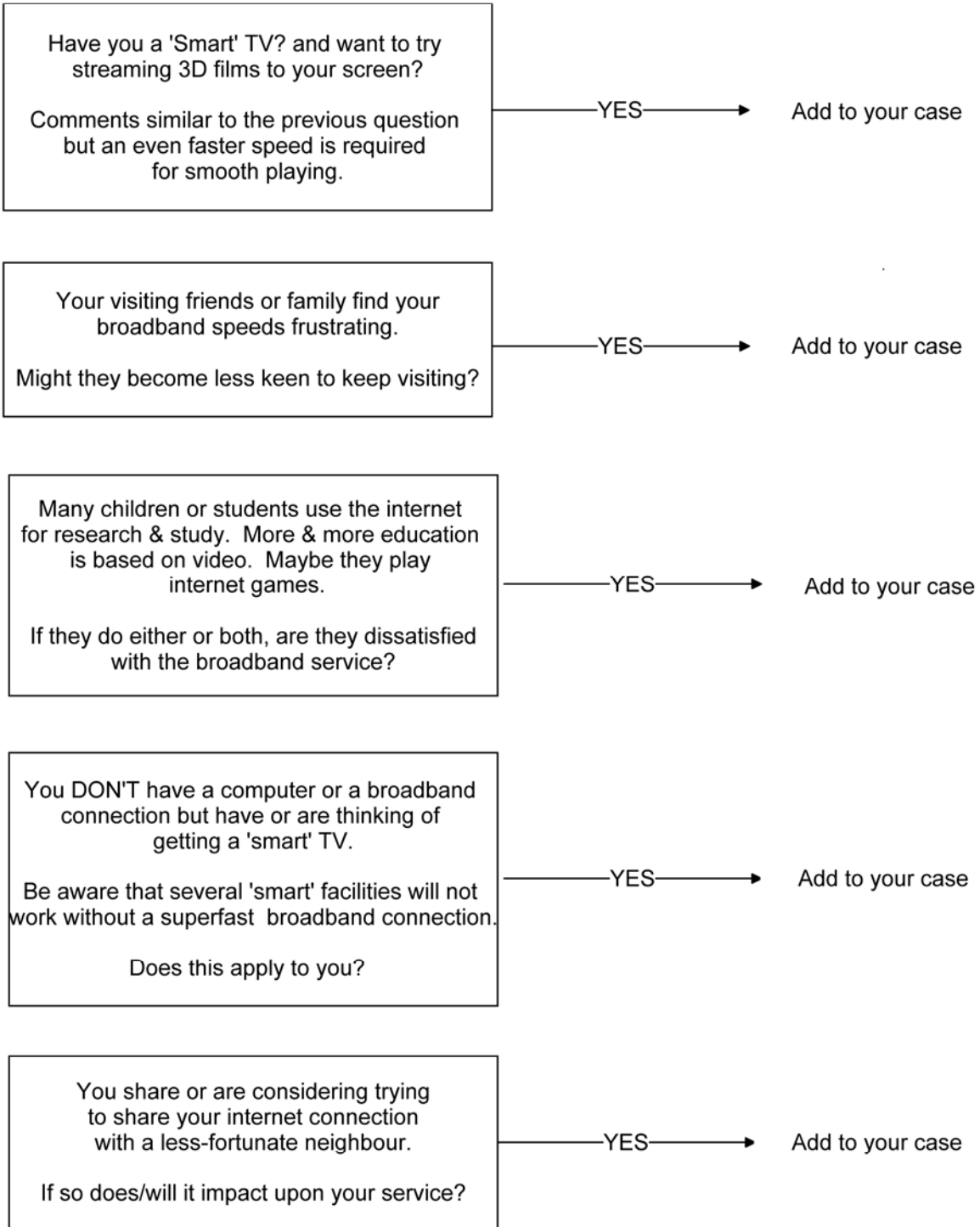
Speed tests carried out in Sedlescombe show a speeds ranging from 2.2Mb to 6.7Mb. Some on 5Mb find that it stutters even on SD programmes.
